

Monterey Township Board Meeting
September 3, 2013

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Nevin Cooper-Keel at 8:00pm at the Community Building. Board members present: Nevin Cooper-Keel, Jennifer Frank, Lois Commons, Earl Collier, and Faye Black

There were 10 citizens present.

Public Comment:

Marybeth Prichard Davis spoke about an upcoming lawsuit they are filing personally against the Bureau of Land Management concerning the upcoming auction of Land in the Allegan State Game Area.

Karon Knoblock reported the planning commission met to rezone the Dame property. Bob Jones with PCI attended the meeting to assist with the process.

Pat Roys asked questions about recent road projects on 126th, asking if this is the project that is supposed to be federally funded. Supervisor Cooper-Keel will call road commission to investigate further.

Black moved supported by Collier to approve the Dame property rezoning as recommended by the planning commission from Ag1 to R1. Motion carried

Cooper-Keel moved supported by Collier that the committed funds in the budget be specified for future fire projects (\$15,000) the remainder to be used for Cemetery Outlay, plotting and unforeseen projects. This is applicable for the 2013-2014 fiscal year budgets. Motion carried.

Cooper-Keel moved supported by Black to approve the Outdoor Wood Burner Ordinance with amendments to Section 8 changing the verbiage regarding grandfathered in units.

Cooper-Keel moved supported by Commons to abstain from issuing a moratorium on hydraulic fracturing at this time, motion carried.

Collier moved supported by Cooper-Keel to approve the August financial statement. Motion Carried.

Commons moved supported by Frank to pay bills. Motion Carried.

Library events calendar was presented via email from the Hopkins Library director.

Cooper-Keel moved supported by Frank to adjourn. Motion carried.
